## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

that we, Leigh F. Jaques of Dover, in the State of New Hampshire  
 and George E. Jaques of

Worcester, Worcester County, Massachusetts,

both

~~being unmarried~~ for consideration paid, grant to George H. Sinnott and Esther K.

Sinnott, husband and wife as tenants by the entirety, both

of said Worcester,

with quietus remainans,

RENTAXX A certain parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, and

(Decks and encumbrances, if any)

all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, situated in  
said Worcester, on the southerly side of Murray Avenue, and bounded  
and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the southerly side of Murray Avenue which is  
 one hundred eighty-nine and one-tenth (189.1) feet distant  
 westerly from the southwesterly side of Wellington Street,  
 measured on said southerly side of Murray Avenue;

THENCE S.  $64\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. by said Murray Avenue sixty-four and one-tenth  
 (64.1) feet to a point at land now or formerly of William  
 E. Allen;

THENCE S.  $25\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to land now  
 or formerly of one Luther Baker;

THENCE N.  $64\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. sixty-four and fifty-five one-hundredths (64.55)  
 feet to a point which is distant one hundred and twenty-five  
 (125) feet from the southerly side of Murray Avenue;

THENCE N.  $24\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to the point of  
 beginning.

The premises are numbered Ninety-one (91) Murray Avenue and  
 the building thereon is known as "The Buckingham".

Subject, however, to the right to pass and repass over a  
 strip six (6) feet in width running the entire length of the north-  
 easterly side of the above described tract, as a private way and as  
 appurtenant to the adjoining property and granting also as appurten-  
 ant to the granted premises a right to pass and repass over a strip  
 of land six (6) feet in width running the entire length of the lot  
 of land on the northeasterly side of the above described lot and ad-  
 joining the same; thereby creating a common passway twelve (12)  
 feet in width for the use and benefit of the owners and occupants of  
 the adjoining tracts.
