and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, all the rest and remain-  
der of my estate, real, personal or mixed, which I may be pos-  
sessed of at the time of my decease; the most of which I believe  
to have been, and now to be in the hands, or under the charge of  
Thomas Johnson, Notary Public of St John Canada East;  
hereby constituting my said brother Joseph Seymour my resid-  
uary legatee and devisee.

Thirdly. I hereby constitute and appoint my said brother  
Joseph Seymour sole Executor of this my last Will and Testa-  
ment, hereby revoking all other wills by me at any time  
herebefore made.
