Norfolk's Commonwealth of Massachusetts

To the Sheriff of our County of Worcester or his Deputy or to any Coroner of the County of Norfolk the office of Sheriff of said County of Norfolk being vacant Greeting  
 Whereas Ebenezer W. Adams of Franklin in our County of Norfolk Labourer by the consideration of our Justices of our Court of Common Pleas holden at Dedham for and within our County of Norfolk aforesaid on the fourth Monday of April current returned judgment against Calvin McCaffee Farmer and James Adams Yeoman both of Franklin in said County of Norfolk for the sum of six hundred and twenty nine dollars and seventy Cents damage and eleven dollars and twenty three Cents costs of suit as to us appears of record whereof Execution remains to be done we command you therefore that of the goods chattels or lands of the said Calvin & James within your precinct you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Ebenezer at the value thereof in money the aforesaid sums being six hundred and forty dollars and ninety three Cents in the whole with twenty five Cents more for this writ and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees and for want of goods Chattels or lands of the said Calvin & James to be by them shown unto you or found within your precinct to the acceptance of the said Ebenezer to satisfy the sums aforesaid we command you to take the bodies of the said Calvin and James and them Commit unto either of our Goals in Dedham or Worcester in our Counties of Norfolk & Worcester aforesaid and detain in your Custody within either of our said Goals until they pay the full sums above mentioned with your fees or that they be discharged by the said Ebenezer W. Adams the Creditor or otherwise by order of Law hereof fail not and make return of this writ with your doing therein into the Clerk's office of our said Court of Common Pleas within three months from the date hereof - Witness Samuel Haven Esquire at Dedham the thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten
