

on the first day of April next another sum of two hundred  
dollars on the first day of January A.D. 1835 with interest &  
another sum of five hundred dollars on the first day  
of January A.D. 1836 with interest annually then this deed  
as also these certain promisory notes bearing date with  
these presents given by the said Holland Albee to the said  
William S. Hastings to pay the same sums with interest at  
the times aforesaid shall all be void otherwise shall  
remain in full force — In witness whereof the said  
Holland Albee and Rosanna Albee his wife in testimony  
of her voluntary relinquishment of her right of dower  
in the aforesaid premises have hereunto set our  
hands and seals this tenth day of August in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three  
Signed sealed and delivered Holland Albee read  
in presence of us Rosanna Albee read  
Charles C. Hastings Worcester Augt 20 1833 then the above  
Larinda Force named Holland Albee acknowledged  
the above instruments to be his free act and deed before  
me Charles C. Hastings Just of Peace

Davenport Seth

Enos Taft

I know all men by these presents that I Seth Davenport  
of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of  
Massachusetts yeoman in consideration of Seven hundred  
& fifty dollars paid by Enos Taft of said Mendon yeoman  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby  
give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said  
Enos Taft his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land  
situated in said Mendon together with a dwel-  
ling house and other buildings standing thereon  
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging  
containing by estimation half an acre or thereabouts more  
or less lies on the southeasterly side of the road  
leading from the house formerly owned by the said  
Enos Taft to the old turnpike and is bounded as follows  
to wit beginning on said road at a corner of James  
Arnolds land thence running southwesterly ten rods to a  
heap of stones bounding southerly by said Arnolds land  
thence northwesterly eight rods to a heap of stones  
bounding on said Arnolds land thence northwesterly ten  
rods to said road & bounded on said Arnolds land  
thence southeasterly to the first mentioned bound & bounded
