 or the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, hereby grant  
 sell and quitclaim unto the said Paul A. Wheeler his heirs  
 and assigns all my right title claim and demands in and  
 unto the following described piece of land situated in said  
 Mendon and bounded as follows to wit, beginning at the  
 northeasterly corner on the westerly side of the road near the  
 dwelling house of the grantee - thence running westerly  
 bounding northerly by land of the grantee about twelve rods  
 to a corner at land of Stephen Cook 2<sup>d</sup> - thence running southerly  
 bounding westerly by land of said Cook to a corner one rod  
 to land of the grantor - thence running easterly by a line run-  
 ning parallel with the line first described to a corner at the  
 road - thence running northerly bounding easterly on said  
 road one rod to the point of beginning, containing by estima-  
 tion twelve square rods the same more or less.  
 To have and to hold the same to the said Paul A. Wheeler his heirs  
 and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do  
 covenant to warrant and defend said granted and quitclaim-  
 ed premises to the said Paul A. Wheeler his heirs and assigns  
 forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons  
 claiming by or under me. In witness whereof we  
 the said George Rawson and Lois P. Rawson wife of the said  
 George Rawson in token of her voluntary relinquishment  
 of her right of dower in said estate have hereunto set our hands  
 and seals this twenty eighth day of March in the year of our
