

Harris Rufus & Betsey Goss. Know all men by these presents that we Rufus Harris of Mendon  
 to in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
 Gentleman and Elmira Harris wife of the said Rufus Harris  
 in consideration of thirty two hundred dollars to us paid by  
 Betsey Goss of said Mendon, Single woman, the receipt whereof  
 we do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey  
 unto the said Betsey Goss her heirs and assigns a certain tract  
 or parcel of land with the buildings thereon and the privileg-  
 es and appurtenances thereto situate in the central part of  
 said Mendon on the Southerly side of the road leading past  
 the dwelling house of Benjamin Davenport in said Mendon  
 containing three acres more or less and bounded and des-  
 cribed in a deed of the same given by Holland Albee  
 to the said Rufus Harris dated the first day of December  
 in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred fifty four and  
 recorded in the Registry of Deeds within and for said  
 County of Worcester Book 551 Page 358 with all the rights  
 to the well on land of Aaron L. Cook and to draw water  
 from the same that are given said Rufus Harris by said deed  
 subject however to the same limitations conditions qualifica-  
 tions and agreements therein referred to and mentioned as  
 the said Rufus Harris and mentioned in a deed of said  
 book and said Holland Albee referred to in the said deed of  
 said Albee to said Harris, the said Elmira Harris wife of the  
 said Rufus Harris joining in this deed with her said hus-  
 band for the purpose and in token of relinquishing all right  
 to homestead which she may have by virtue of any law of this  
 Commonwealth in relation to homestead rights.

To have and to hold the afore granted premises to the said  
 Betsey Goss her heirs and assigns to her and their use and behoof  
 forever. And we do for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators  
 covenant with the said Betsey Goss her heirs and assigns  
 that the said Rufus Harris is lawfully seized in fee of the  
 afore granted premises: that they are free of all incumbrances  
 except as herein mentioned and referred to, that we have good  
 right to sell and convey the same to the said Betsey Goss and  
 that we will warrant and defend the same premises to the  
 said Betsey Goss her heirs and assigns forever against the  
 lawful claims and demands of all persons. And I the said  
 Elmira wife of the said Rufus Harris for the consideration  
 aforesaid do hereby release and quit claim unto the said Betsey
