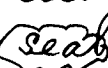

Daniels and Alongo Hall, that we have good right to sell and convey the same to the said George W. Wilcox and that we will warrant and defend the same premises to the said George W. Wilcox his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof we the said George Rawson and Lois Rawson in her right as aforesaid and in token of her release to all claim to dower in the premises aforesaid have hereunto set our hands and seals this seventh day of December A.D. 1857.
