 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Elizabeth W. Haft
 the several tracts or parcels of Land herein described, all situate in
 said Mendon. The first tract or parcel of land is the Homestead
 Farm of the grantor situate on both sides of the road leading from
 Albeville to Mendon containing fifty four acres, and one hundred
 and eight rods be the same more or less, with the dwelling house,
 barn and other buildings thereon. The tract of land on the
