cept giving notice of the time and place of sale once at least in each of three successive weeks in one newspaper printed in the County of Worcester and in their own names or as the attorneys of the Grantor or his heirs or assigns for that purpose by these presents duly authorized convey the same or any part thereof absolutely and in fee simple to the purchaser or purchasers accordingly: and out of the money arising from such sale to retain all sums then secured by this deed (whether then or thereafter payable) together with interest and all costs of any suit either on said note or mortgage and all expenses incurred in such sale; paying the surplus if any to the Grantor or his assigns and such sale shall forever bar the Grantor and all persons claiming by or under him from all right and interest in the premises. It being mutually agreed that the Grantees their successors or assigns may purchase at said sale and that no other purchaser shall be answerable for the application of the purchase money.

AND PROVIDED ALSO that until some breach of the conditions of this deed the Grantees shall have no right to enter and take possession of the premises.
