to Kinley of Mendon in the County of Worcester and common Christopher Daniels, wealth of Massachusetts, in her own right, in consideration of See Possession in four hundred dollars paid by Christopher Daniels of said Mendon Book 1164, Page 495 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Christopher Daniels his heirs and assigns the following described real estate situated at the corner of Hastings and Elm Street in said Mendon viz: Beginning at a point in Hastings Street opposite the front door of the house, thence to the middle of the said door thence through the middle of the entry to the back door thence in a straight line to the barn, thence turning and running to the South-westerly corner of the barn, thence turning & running Southeasterly by and with said barn to the Southeasterly corner of the same thence turning and running Northeasterly by and with said barn to a stake & stones at one half the distance from land of Anna H. Hastings to Elm Street, thence turning and running Southeasterly in a straight line to a stake and stones at land of Sumner Ballou at one half of the distance from land of said Hastings to said Elm Street, thence turning and running Southwest by land of said Ballou to Elm Street thence by and with said Elm Street and Hastings Street to the point of beginning, reverting to Francis E. Kinley her heirs and assigns the use of the doors and entry aforesaid the claim to the 2<sup>nd</sup> story, the attic and the cellar and the use of the well, she or they paying for one half of the necessary repairs with all the buildings thereon.
