Now all men by these presents that we, Thomas B. Staples of Worcester and Sara L. Staples of Mendon both in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Legates of Hamilton B. Staples in consideration of Fifty dollars paid by Henrietta L. Rhodes of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Henrietta L. Rhodes, a certain tract or parcel of land situated in Mendon aforesaid and bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a stone bound set in the ground in the continuation of a straight line from the centre of a stone post at the southeasterly corner of other land of the grantee, through the centre of the well between the premises of the grantor and the grantee, said stone bound being eight rods and twenty-two links from said stone post; thence Westerly with grantee's other land to land formerly of Lewis Stone; thence Northerly on said Stone land as the wall now stands to land of Mary B. Aldrich thence Easterly on said Aldrich land, seven rods and eleven links to a stone post set in the ground thence Southerly to the point of beginning, bound-
