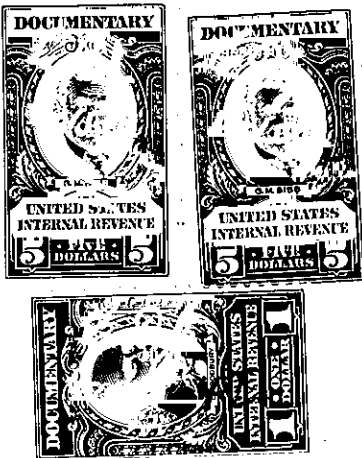

A certain tract or parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated on the northerly side of Hastings Street in said Mendon, being bounded and described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a stone post set in the ground in the northerly line of said Hastings Street and at the southwesterly corner of the Parsonage property (so-called); thence westerly on said Hastings Street 120 feet to a stone post set in the ground; thence northerly to a stone post set in the ground; thence N. 57° E. 120 feet to a stone post set in the ground at the northwesterly corner of said Parsonage property, the last 2 lines bounding on land of one Hersey, formerly of one Adams; and thence S. 24° 45' E. by said Parsonage property 237.5 feet to the point of beginning.
