I Joseph H. Davenport of the town, in the County of Worcester being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, as follows viz:

I give devise and bequeath to my wife Mary H. Davenport the use and income of all my estate, real personal and mixed, during her natural life. Subject however to the following duties and obligations: she shall cloth and support my daughter Mary H. Bartlett while she shall remain single during the life of my said wife, and she shall clothe support and educate my son Edward H. Davenport until he shall arrive at the age of twenty one years.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Betsey Fuller at the decease of her mother if she shall be living at

that time the use and income of one thousand dollars of bank stock during her life, and if I shall die leaving no bank stock, I direct my executor hereinafter named to purchase in the name of good bank stock for the purpose of fulfilling this legacy.

At the decease of my daughter Betsey Fuller leaving a child or children I direct my said executor to transfer said share, or pay the sum of one thousand dollars to her child or children in equal proportions, and in case my said daughter Betsey shall leave no child said share & money shall be disposed of in the same manner as the property disposed of by the residuary clause in this my last will and testament.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary H. Bartlett to be paid at the decease of her mother the sum of thirty five hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to my son Edward H. Davenport to be paid at the decease of his mother the sum of thirty five hundred dollars.

I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Mary H. Bartlett one undivided third part of all the real and real due of my estate.

I give devise and bequeath to my son Edward H. Davenport, one undivided third part of all the real and real due of my estate.

I give devise and bequeath to Aaron B. Mayhew of Milford one undivided third part of all the real and real due of my estate, to be held by him, in trust for the use and benefit of my son Edward H. Davenport, during his natural life, unless my said son should request said Aaron B. Mayhew in writing to convey the same estate to him absolutely, and in case he should make such request I hereby direct the said Aaron B. Mayhew to make a conveyance according to said request, and in case of the death of my said son without said request being made, I direct the said Aaron B. Mayhew to convey or pay over said estate to the family of my said son Edward, in the same proportions as they would have been entitled to the same, in case my said son had died the legal owner thereof.
