

wall to land of Seth Davenport, bounding Southly on said Benjamin Leggs
heir son land of the grantee, then turning & running Northly with the wall,
then turning & running Easterly to the town road aforesaid, the two last lines
bounding on the said Seth Davenport's land, thence running Northly and
bounding Easterly on said town road till it comes to a point opposite
the Northwesterly corner of the Rev. Simeon Daggetts pasture, which is
situated on the Easterly side of said road road, thence crossing said road
to said corner, thence running Easterly as the fence now stands bounding
on said Daggetts land, thence turning & running in a various line in
a Northly direction, where the fence now stands, till it comes to land
of the grantee, bounding Easterly partly on land of the said Daggett,
partly on land of the heirs of William Torry partly on Oliver B. Everetts land
on land of Benjamin Davenport, thence Westly with the wall to the
town road aforesaid bounding Northly on land of the grantee, then
turning & running with said road Southly to a point opposite to the
first mentioned bound, thence crossing said road to the first men-
tioned bound, with a dwellinghouse & other buildings standing there
on — The second tract or parcel of land contains twenty two acres of
wood land & meadow, be the same more or less, is bounded as follows to wit
beginning at a heap of stones a few rods Northly from the saw mill of
Obadiah Wood in Mendon, thence running Northly to a heap of stones
at a corner of land of the heirs of William Torry, of the grantee's land
& of Samuel Bills land bounding on land of said William Torry's heirs,
thence turning & running Westly to another heap of stones at a first stone
bounding partly on land of George Taft & partly on land of Samuel
Bills, thence turning & running Southly to a heap of stones at land of
the heirs of Benjamin Legg & bounding on land owned by Peki or Mark
Aldrich, thence Southly to another heap of stones, to land of said Peki or
Mark Aldrich bounding on said Benjamin Leggs heirs, thence turning &
running Easterly to the first mentioned bound bounding on the said
Aldrich's land in part, & in part on land of Simon Thornton — The third
tract or parcel of land, contains ten acres, be the same more or less, con-
sisting of pasture & wood land is bounded as follows to wit, beginning at a
corner of the wall at the corner of Stephen Willard's land on the Northly
side of the said County road leading from Mendon by said Willard's dwell-
house to My bridge & Northbridge, thence running Northly as the wall &
fence now stand to a stake & stones at land of Benoni Hayward &
bounding on said Willard's land, thence turning & running Westly to
a heap of stones bounding on said Hayward's land, thence turning &
running Southly to a chesnut stump with a stake in it, thence in
a Northwesterly course to a heap of stones at the meadow road,

said Elisha Wood, thence on said meadow road to the County road
