Adams David to Riley Mitchell

Know all Men by these Presents, that I David Adams of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Yeoman in consideration of one hundred dollars paid by Riley Mitchell of said Mendon Yeoman the receipt, whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do give, grant sell and convey unto the said Riley Mitchell his heirs and assigns a certain piece of land situated in said Mendon, lying on the westerly side of the Road leading from Aaron C. Cook's by the house of Welcome Staples, bounded and described as follows to wit: bounded easterly on said Road, 7 rods and 7 links: southerly on said Riley Mitchell's land 11 3/4 rods: westerly on land of Stephen Cook 2 1/2 rods and 7 links: northerly on land of George Rawson, 11 3/4 rods: said piece of land containing eighty five rods and eight links be the same more or less. The condition of this deed is such that the fence on the line between said Mitchell and Rawson is to be built and forever maintained by said Rawson according to the condition in the deed from Ezra Seland to said Adams, and also the condition in the deed of Ezra Seland to the said George Rawson This being the same piece of land conveyed by deed to the said David Adams by Ezra Seland, dated January 1st A. D. 1846 and recorded in Registry of deeds Book 412. Page 244.
