hereby renounce, release and forever quit-claim, unto the said George
Wood, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land, situated in said
Mendon, upon the westerly side of the road leading from the house
of Welcome Staples, to the road to Northbridge, and bounded as follows-
viz. Beginning at a point, upon the westerly side of said road, at the
N.E. corner of land improved by Elisha Wood - thence by and with said
