for consideration paid, grant to Lucille Martin

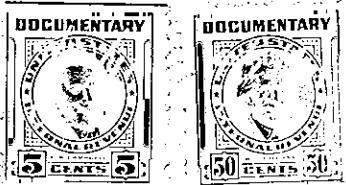
of said Mendon with warranty covenants

Being a portion of the premises described in a deed of Irene B. Stone Boss to these grantors, dated September 5, 1945, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 2969, page 470.
