I know all men by these presents that I Barnard Harrington of Northborough in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Matter — In consideration of three thousand dollars paid by Suke Howe of the same Northborough aforesaid Gentleman — The receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do here- by give grant sell and convey unto the said Suke Howe a certain farm with all the buildings thereon and is situate in the Southeast- uly part of the aforesaid Northboro, and contains one hundred acres of land be the same more or less and is bounded as followeth viz beginning at the Southeast Corner of said farm at or near the town line by a town road leading to Westboro, thence S 00° W. as the wall stands about thirty three rods to an Oak stump near the meadow thence S 67° W. crossing the meadow by a ditch & continuing about fifty one rods to a stake and stone an angle in the fence thence S. 02° W. twelve rods & half rod to a corner a stake & stone at Capt. Gales land (these three lines above named join on land of Co. Peters) thence by said Gales
