Gunn Emeline M. &c. Know all men by these presents, that we, Emeline M. Gunn, to Nathan G. Daniels and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Six hundred and fifty dollars paid by Nathan G. Daniels, of Mendon in said County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Nathan G. Daniels, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land of land with the buildings thereon, situated on the Southern side of the road leading from Albeville in said Mendon, to Wbridge, and containing fifty acre, be the same more or less, bounded on the North by said road, on the West by grantors land, on the South by Austin Woods land, on the East by a road leading from said Albeville to Chestnut Hill Meeting house and Richardsons land and the school house lot. Also one other tract containing ten acres, be the same more or less, and situated on the Northern side of said Wbridge road and opposite of the same on the first described tract, and bounded Southernly on said road, on the East by the Blanchard land, as called, on the North by said Blanchard land and land of Alanson Taft, on the West by James M^c Kenneys land and Luther E. Tafts. Also one other tract containing ten acres, be the same more or less, being sprout and meadow land, and bounded on the South by James M^c Kenneys land, on the East by Alanson Tafts land and land belonging to the Heirs of Royal M. Wheelock, on the North by Luther E. Tafts land, and on the West by grantors land and land belonging to Peter Morris.
