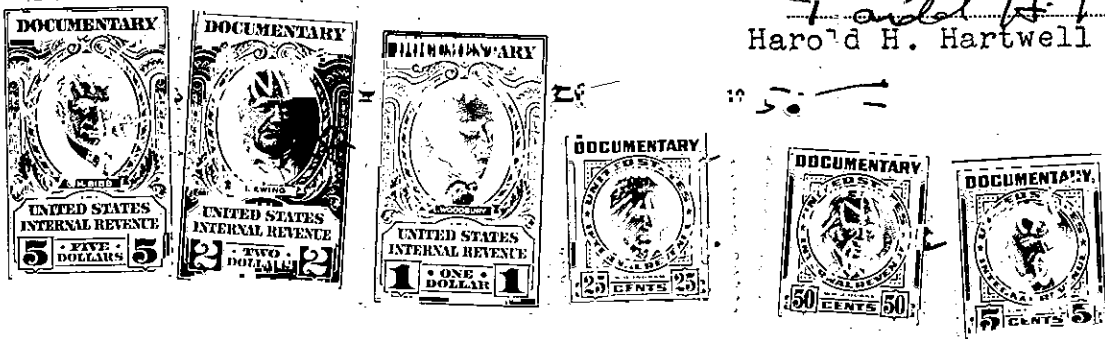

I, William J. Hazard

of Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts,
being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to Herbert H. Mathewson and Elizabeth L. Mathewson, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, both of said Mendon with quitclaim covenants

~~wherein~~ a certain parcel of land situated on the northerly side of the road formerly known as the Boston and Hartford Turnpike, in said Mendon, (Description and encumbrances, if any)

and now called Uxbridge Road, and being shown on a plan recorded in Worcester District Registry of Deeds entitled "Land in Mendon, Mass., deeded by William J. Hazard to Herbert Mathewson et ux, Scale 1" = 100', September 19, 1951, Plan and Survey by Arthur H. Fitzgerald", and bounded and described on said plan as follows:

- On the southerly side by said Uxbridge Road 296.53 feet;
- On the easterly side by remaining land of William J. Hazard, 373.40 feet;
- On the northerly side by remaining land of William J. Hazard, 297.08 feet;
- On the northwesterly side by land this day deeded to Lyman E. Hazard, 517.51 feet.

Said granted premises being a part of the third parcel in deed of Clarence Ellis to William J. Hazard, dated April 12, 1948, and recorded in Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Book 3115, page 28.

This deed is to confirm and correct the second course in the deed between the same parties dated November 16, 1951, and recorded in said Registry, Book 3380, Page 210

The consideration is such that no federal documentary stamps are hereto affixed.
