Know all men by these presents

that I, Henry W. Gaskill, of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations, paid by John R. O'Neil, of Hopedale in said County,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John R. O'Neil, a certain tract or parcel of land situated on Mendon Pond, so-called, in said Town of Mendon, and bounded and described as follows: beginning at a stake at the northeasterly corner of said tract and on the shore of said pond; thence N. 54 degs. W. with other land of the grantor, 90 feet to the Uxbridge road; thence S. 27 degs. 10 min. W., 46 feet, and S. 34 degs. 55 min. W., 4 feet with said road to land formerly of the grantor, but conveyed by deed not yet recorded to John H. Cunningham; thence S. 54 degs. E. with said Cunningham land, 100 feet to a stake at the shore of said pond; thence northerly or northeasterly on the shore of said pond to the point of beginning.

Said tract or parcel being designated as "B 8" in the subdivisions of Lot B as shown on plan of land of Henry W. Gaskill filed with certificate of registered land number 291 in Worcester District Registry of Deeds.

B. 8.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said John R. O'Reil

and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever.

And I hereby for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, concernant with the grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee-simple of the granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances;

that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and before the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And for the consideration aforesaid I, Amy B. Gaskill, wife of the said Henry W. Gaskill,

do hereby release unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises, and all other rights and interests therein.
