and seventy two cents costs of suit as to which appears of re
cord whereof Execution remains to be done we command
you therefore that of the goods chattels or lands of the said
Elisha within your precinct you cause to be paid and
satisfied unto the said Timothy at the value thereof in
money the aforesaid sum being three hundred & ninety
eight dollars and forty one cents in the whole with
twenty five cents more for this writ and thereof also to satisfy
yourself for your own fees and for want of goods chattels
or lands of the said Elisha to be by him shown unto you
or your friend within your precinct to the acceptance of the said
Timothy to satisfy the sums aforesaid we command you to
take the body of the said Elisha Parkhurst and him commit
unto our goal in Worcester in our County of Worcester aforesaid
& detain in your custody within our said goal until he pay
the full sum above mentioned with your fees or that he be
discharged by the said Timothy Whiting the creditor or other
wise by order of Law hereof fail not and make return of this
writ with your doings therein unto our said Court of Common
Pleas to be holden at Dedham within our County of Norfolk
