other buildings standing thereon, situate in the Northerly part of said
Mendon bounded as follows, to wit, beginning on the North side of the
road which leads by Stephen Woods to Northbridge at the Southwest
corner of Stephen Woods orchard thence North $15\frac{1}{3}$ West $6\frac{1}{3}$ rods thence
North 31° West $5\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a heap of stones thence South $81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West $78\frac{1}{3}$
rods, bounding on said Woods land thence South $19\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East 68 rods to
