Know all men by these presents that I Manning Rawson of Mendon County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts in consideration of the sum of fourteen hundred and forty dollars paid by David Davenport of said Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Davenport his heirs and assigns the following tracts of land with all the buildings privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging. The first tract is situated in said Mendon on the North side of the old Hartford Turnpike road so called and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a heap of stones at the Southeast corner of land belonging to Nathan George of said Mendon and running Northeast and with said George's land as the fences now stand to land of Silas Dudley of said ^{Mendon} then North with said Dudley's ^{land as the fences now stand to the centre of muddy brook so called then South with the centre of said brook to land of said Gaskiel of said Mendon then Southwest and South with said Gaskiel's land as the fences now stand to the old Hartford turnpike road then West with said road to the first mentioned bound at the corner of Nathan George's land containing twenty three acres more or less.}

The second tract is situated in said Mendon and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a heap of stones at the ~~at~~ old eight rod road so called at the Southeast corner of land belonging to Amaria Taft of said Mendon and running West with said Taft's land as the fences now stand to a town road then South with said road to land of Nathaniel Gaskiel of said Mendon then East South and East with said Gaskiel's land as the fences now stand to the old eight rod road then North with said road to the first mentioned bound containing thirty three acres more or less.
