

of the money arising from such sale, to retain all sums then secured by this deed (whether then or thereafter payable) together with interest, and all costs and expenses of, or attending to, any suit or proceeding at law or in equity, either on or concerning said note or mortgage, including advice and counsel fees, and all expenses incurred in such sale; paying the surplus, if any, to the grantor or her assigns; and such sale shall forever bar the grantor and all persons claiming by or under her from all right and interest in the premises. It being mutually agreed that the grantee, its successors or assigns, may purchase at said sale, and that no other purchaser shall be answerable for the application of the purchase money. And provided also, that until some breach of the conditions of this deed, the grantee shall have no right to enter and take possession of the premises. And the wife of the said for the consideration, do hereby release and quitclaim unto said Bank, its successors and assigns, all the right, title, claim or demand she may have in and to the premises hereby conveyed, or under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws, and also all right, claim or possibility of dower in said premises.
