

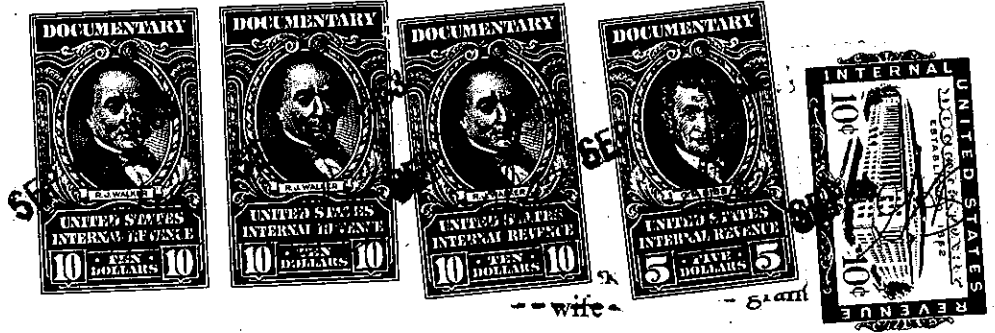
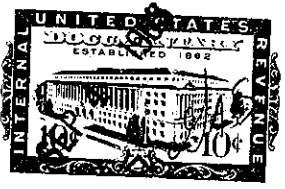
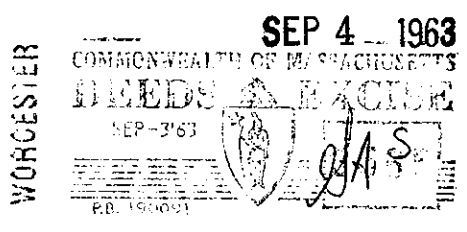
We, G. Arthur Small and Violet H. Small, husband and wife,
