

Still so called, being land that Simon Smith formerly purchased of Samuel Newson together with the remainder of my land at Chaswell Hill that I have not given to Thomas Aldrich, agreeing to that containing about twenty acres, to be equally divided between them their heirs and assigns forever -

I then give and bequeath unto my son George Aldrich, all my lands and buildings by the Friends Meeting house lying on both sides of the road together with the lot known by the name of Innersons lot containing about four acres together with my woodland lying the North side of Tappan pond, so called, containing about ten acres, also all the woodland I own lying on the Pond Hills, except what I gave to Zachary Taft being about twenty acres, these lands above mentioned I give to my son George, I will him to pay the legacies hereafter mentioned, viz, that he shall pay and perform in the manner following the said George shall let my Daughter Mary Nichols have the use of my shop formerly my trading shop near the Friends Meeting House) to live in and store her goods in the use of as much of the Cellar under said room as she shall have occasion for and also a privilege of using the well as much as she shall have occasion for as long as she shall remain a single woman - and to pay her the said Mary Nichols four pounds ten shillings once every six months after my decease so long as she shall remain a single woman, to be paid in money or in such Receipts of Sale as she shall find in need of a money price, also the said George to pay my grand daughter Elizabeth Bruce eighty pounds, to be paid in the manner following, viz, twenty pounds in One year after my decease, and then twenty pounds annually till the eighty pounds is paid - Also the said George is to pay to my three grand children, viz, Richard Bolton, Polly Bolton and Mary Bolton fifteen pounds each, to be paid to each of them when they shall arrive at lawfull age to give him a discharge for the same, in case any of the above mentioned him should not live to arrive to lawfull age, then their parts to be paid to those that shall survive - Also the said George to pay to my Daughter Phela Bolton fifteen pounds to be paid seven pounds ten shillings to be paid in one year after my decease, the other seven pounds ten shillings in two years after my decease - Also the said George to pay my Daughter Delphica Strauch twenty pounds, to be paid forty shillings in one year after my decease and then forty shillings annually untill the twenty pounds is paid - Also the said George to pay all cost and charge of settling my estate agreeable to this my will - when the within named legacies and Performances shall be performed and complyed with then the within named premises to be the said Georges his heirs and assigns forever -

I then give and bequeath unto my grand son Thomas Aldrich my other Cloths not heretofore disposed of -

I then give to my two sons Dan Aldrich and George Aldrich all my wearing apparel and all my printed Books to be equally divided between them -

I then give and bequeath to my two sons Dan Aldrich and George Aldrich (and my three grandsons Ebenezer Aldrich, Parson Aldrich and Arthur Aldrich all my live Stock, not heretofore disposed of as a horned Cattle Sheep and Swine & all my farming tools and out door moveables to be equally divided amongst them -

I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Delphica Strauch one third part of my Inceor moveables not heretofore disposed of -

I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Nichols, to my Daughter Phela Bolton and my grand Daughter Abigail Taft and my grand Daughter Elizabeth Bruce the other two thirds of all my inceor moveables not heretofore disposed of to be equally divided amongst them -

I then it is my will that if I have any money or Securities for money at my decease more than to pay my just debts and funeral charges (not making the charges settling my estate, which I have heretofore secured upon George to pay, the same shall be equally divided between my children, viz Dan Aldrich, George Aldrich, Mary Nichols, Phela Bolton and Delphica Strauch -

I then it is my will that my real estate shall not be appraised after my decease -

Finally I hereby nominate and appoint my trusty and well beloved son George Aldrich the sole executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking dissolving and making void all former or other wills and bequests by me made, do declare this to be my last will and Testament - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth Day of January in the year of our Lord 1797, and in the 21st year of the Independence of the United States, published pronounced and declared by the said George Aldrich to be his last will and Testament in the presence of
