Know all men by these presents that I, Luke Aldrich of Mendon, in the county of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, yeoman, in consideration of three thousand dollars paid by Seth S. Aldrich of Smithfield, Edwin P. Aldrich of New York city, Benjamin S. Aldrich of Mendon and Moses Aldrich of said Mendon, all sons of said Luke Aldrich, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Seth S. Aldrich, Edwin P. Aldrich, Benjamin S. Aldrich & Moses Aldrich, their heirs and assigns, a certain farm lying in the Westerly part of Mendon with all the buildings thereon, bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at Rock meadow brook at Perry Wood's land on the Northerly side of the road formerly the Boston & Hartford turnpike: thence West-erly to Seth S. Aldrich's land by and with said road: thence Northerly & West-erly by said Seth S. Aldrich land to Perry Wood's land: thence Northerly by said Perry Wood's & Luke Farnum land till it comes to Burton Philson's land: thence a various line on said Philson land till it comes to a town road leading from Leonard Taft to Daniel Farnum's over West Hill: thence East-erly on said road to Amariah A. Taft's land: thence South-erly on said Taft's land to Lyman Cook's land various times on said Cook's land till it comes to Daniel Farnum's land: thence on said Daniel Farnum's land till it comes to land belonging to the heirs of Benjamin Segg deceased: thence various courses on said heirs land and Lewis Wood's land till it comes to the heirs of Simon Thorington, deceased: thence on said Thorington's land till it comes to Perry Wood's land at said brook: thence down stream of said brook till it comes to the place of beginning. It being all the land and buildings that I own in Mendon, containing one hundred and forty acres, be the same more or less. I have and to hold the afore granted premises to the said Seth S.
