cember 8th 1865 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds at Worcester
Book 714 Page 216, the line running thence by and with said
land conveyed to said Bascome by said Bates to land now own-
ed by said Laban Bates. Subject to a right of way through and
over a driveway between the dwelling house situated upon said
premises and the shop before mentioned which way shall not be
closed except by the mutual consent of the owner of said shop
and the owner of said house. So have and to hold
