

Southerly on land formerly of Lyman Cook; thence on said wall 44 rods and 16 links N. $8^{\circ} W.$ bounding Easterly on Aldrich land to the West Hill road; thence Westerly on said road 46 rods and 11 links to corner of a wall; thence on said wall S. $23^{\circ} E.$ $21\frac{1}{5}$ rods to a corner of a wall; thence S. $71^{\circ} W.$ $20\frac{1}{5}$ rods to a corner of a wall; thence S. $16^{\circ} E.$ 28 rods and 16 links to a corner of a wall; thence N. $63^{\circ} E.$ $11\frac{1}{2}$ rods to a corner of a wall; thence S. $17\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} E.$ 57 rods and 19 links; thence S. $1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} E.$ 21 rods and 9 links; thence S. $5^{\circ} E.$ 6 rods and 3 links to corner of wall; thence N. $66^{\circ} W.$ 11 rods 19 links to a corner of wall the last 8 lines bordering Westerly and Northerly on land of heirs of John Broughy; thence on said wall S. $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$ 76 rods; thence S. $3^{\circ} W.$ $25\frac{1}{5}$ rods to corner of wall bounding Westerly on land formerly of Austin and Perry Wood; thence on wall N. $86\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} E.$ $16\frac{1}{2}$ rods; thence S. $7^{\circ} W.$ $22\frac{1}{2}$ rods; thence S. $79^{\circ} E.$ $2\frac{4}{5}$ rods; thence S. $9\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$ $8\frac{1}{5}$ rods to said Turnpike; the last four lines bounding Westerly on land of Stephen Cook; thence by and with said Turnpike 70 rods to the place of beginning containing 125 acres more or less.

And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
