A certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in the southerly part of said Boylston, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of said lot at an iron pin driven into the ground on the easterly side of the county road leading from Boylston Center to Worcester and called Main Street, said point being distant northerly four hundred (400) feet from the corner of the wall on the line dividing the land now or formerly of Brigham from the land formerly owned by one George A. Flagg; and running thence east by land now or formerly of Elisha Raynor, three hundred ninety two and five tenths (392.5) feet to a stake; thence N. 78°W, three hundred and fifty (350) feet by land now or formerly of Ina A. Taft to an iron pin at the easterly side of said County Road; thence by said County road southerly about one hundred and ten (110) feet to the point of beginning. Containing 219,250 square feet of land, more or less. Being the same premises conveyed to Frank H. Mores and Carrie E. Mores by Ina A. Taft wife of Leroy W. Taft by deed dated August 2, 1932 and recorded with the Worcester District Registry of Deeds Book 2568 Page 144. Said Frank H. Mores now being deceased.
