Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth  
of Massachusetts to Samuel G. Wilcox late of Massachusetts payment in consideration of one  
hundred and twenty Dollars paid by Samuel G. Wilcox  
of Mendon aforesaid received the receipt whereof I do her-  
eby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey  
unto the said Samuel G. Wilcox his heirs and assigns  
a certain piece of land situated in the first Parish in  
Mendon in said County containing about one third of  
an acre both the same more or less with a dwelling  
house thereon bounded East by the road leading  
by Amie Brook to Almoe Hill South by land of Cor-  
nelius Metcalf on all other parts by said Cornelius  
land the said premises being the same that I purchased  
of Anson M. Gaffey and that said Anson M. Gaffey  
purchased of James Sherman with all the privileges  
and appurtenances thereto belonging  
I have and to hold the aforesaid premises to  
the said Samuel G. Wilcox his heirs and assigns to his &  
their use and behoof forever and I do for myself  
my heirs executors and administrators covenant with  
the said Samuel G. Wilcox his heirs and assigns that  
I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises  
that they and free of all encumbrances that I  
have good right to sell and convey the same to the said  
Samuel G. Wilcox and that I will warrant and defend  
the same premises to the said Samuel G. Wilcox his heirs  
and assigns forever against the lawful claims and de-  
mands of all persons . . . . In witness whereof I the  
said Asa Chilson and Elizabeth Chilson wife of the  
said Asa Chilson relinquish all her right to dinner
