

two last lines being on said Whelock's land, thence Easterly on a stone wall 12 rods 19 links, thence N. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 48 rods 12 links to corner of walls, thence Easterly to the first mentioned road, the last three lines being on Perry Woods land, thence Northward on said road about ten and one half rods to the point of beginning. Reserving for Perry Wood his heirs and assigns the right to pass and repass from the first mentioned road over the granted premises as received by said Wood in a deed to grantor recorded in the Registry of Deeds for Worcester County, Book 807, Page 551.
