Davis to the above mentioned road, thence Northerly on said road to place of beginning. Being all the land and the buildings thereon. The whole of said premises were deeded to us by Charles Pomeroy Executor of the estate of Warren W. Mason of Northfield Mass. by leave of the Judge of Probate Court.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Albert H. Albee and his heirs and assigns to their nominees and behof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs executors, and administrators covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that the granted premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me, and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me but against none other. And for the consideration aforesaid I, Henry R. Albee and Clara Albee wife of Henry R. Albee do hereby release unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
