long of sound memory, disposing mind and understanding, considering
the uncertainty of human life, and being desirous of settling my worldly
affairs and directing how my property shall be disposed of after my death
make and publish this my last Will and Testament, hereby witness and
making null and void all other Wills by me heretofore made.

1st My will is that all my just debts and charges shall first be paid
by my Executor hereinafter named, out of the Personal Estate that I
may leave, as soon as convenient after my decease.

2^d I give herewith and devise to my wife Sally Cook the use and
enjoyment of one half of my dwelling House and one half of the
cellar and the same with the use of the garden back of the House
and an equal privilege in the garden, in front of the House; to have and to
hold all the same during her natural life; I also give her one half of my
household furniture, and indoor ornaments, and fifty dollars in money
to be paid her by my Executor out of my personal Estate, as soon as
convenient after my decease; I furthermore order and direct my first
son hereinafter named, each to pay her my said wife the sum of five
Dollars of carig and every year during her natural life; and each one of
them to bind, provide and deliver her at her house, eight pds of good hard
Wood for her use yearly; and I furthermore order and direct each of my
four daughters hereinafter named, to pay her the sum of four Dollars and
fifty Cents yearly and every year during her natural life, and each one of
them provide and deliver her at her house four pds of good hard wood
for her use yearly, the first payments of the money and wood to be made
in one year after my decease.

3^r I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ursula McAffee the sum of
one hundred dollars to be paid her by my Executor out of my Estate
in one year from my decease.

4th I give herewith and devise to my two sons viz. Elsey Cook
Hiram Cook, Ariel Cook, Stephen Cook and Clark Cook, ten thirds
of all my Real and Personal Estate, not before bequeathed, including two
thirds of the Real Estate before devised my wife during her life, to them
three sons, & assigns forever.

5th I give, bequeath and devise to my four daughters viz. Ursula McAffee
Elizabeth Chisholm wife of Asa Chisholm, Hannah Staples wife of John
Staples and Sally Wilcox wife of Samuel G. Wilcox, one third each
of my Real and Personal Estate not before bequeathed including one third of
the Real Estate before devised my wife during her life, to them their
and assigns forever to each one sole and separate use, free from the
interference and control of their Husband - and my will is that
the respective shares in said Real Estate shall stand charged with the
annual payment of the respective sums to my wife, and the delivery
of said pds Wood.

6th I nominate and appoint my son Elsey Cook, to be the sole
Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
