Smith Edward L. Know all men by these presents that I,
 Edward L. Smith of Mendon in the County of Worcester
 and Commonwealth of Massachusetts in consideration of
 Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800) paid by Augustus W. Westcott
 of Hopedale in said County, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and con-
 vey unto the said Augustus W. Westcott, a certain tract
 or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in the
 central Village of said Mendon on the Westerly side of the
 road leading from Worcester to Providence and opposite to the
 Town Hall and bounded as follows. Beginning at the South-
 westerly corner of the premises at a stone set in the ground
 with a hole drilled in the top at land of Julius A. George,
 thence S. 36 $\frac{2}{3}$ ^o E. 2 rods 21 links to a hole drilled in a rock,
 thence S. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o W. 1 rod 3 links to a stone with a hole drilled in the
 top, thence S. 37 $\frac{2}{3}$ ^o E. 10 rods 18 links to a stone with a hole
 drilled in the top; thence N. 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ ^o E. 4 rods 9 links, to a
 heap of stones; thence N. 39 $\frac{1}{3}$ ^o W. 10 links to a stake, thence
 N. 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ ^o E. 1 rod 10 links to a stake at said road the lines above
 given bounding on land of said Julius A. George and land
 of Marcus M. Alrich, thence N. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o W. 12 rods 11 links bound-
 ing on said road, thence S. 61 $\frac{2}{3}$ ^o W. 4 rods 14 links to the point
 of beginning containing 71 rods more or less. It being the
 same and all the premises conveyed to me by deed of Lois
 Rawson, Mary Rawson and Salona A. Crane to be recorded,
 said deed bearing date June 16th 1886. To have and to
 hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereto belonging to the said Augustus W. Westcott and
