I know all men by these presents that I Philip
 Ammidon of Boston in the County of Suffolk & Commonwealth
 of Massachusetts Merchants in consideration of Eight hundred
 and fifty dollars paid by Jonathan Russell of Providence
 in the County of Providence and State of Rhode Island & Pro-
 vidence Plantations Gentlemen the receipt whereof I do
 hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey
 unto the said Jonathan Russell all the land devised to me
 by the last will and testament of my Hon. Father Philip
 Ammidon Esquire late of Mendon in the County of Wor-
 cester Commonwealth aforesaid said land lying and being
 in the said Town of Mendon together with all the buildings
 thereon being bettered and bounded as followeth that is to say
 southerly and southerly by the turnpike road Easterly
 by Luke Aldrich's land Northerly by the south line of
 the Land purchased by my Hon. Father aforesaid of Simon
 Staples and now owned by my Brother Otis Ammidon there
 being about twenty acres of said land in the same more
 or less —

To have and to hold the aforesaid premises
 to the said Jonathan Russell in him and assigns to him use
 and behoof forever and I do covenant with the said Jona-
 than Russell in him and assigns that I am lawfully seized
 in fee of the aforesaid premises that they are free of all incum-
 brances that I have good right to sell and convey the same
 to the said Jonathan Russell and that I will warrant and
 defend the same premises to the said Jonathan Russell
 and his assigns and defend the same to the said
