Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Barber of Worcester in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Stonecutter in consideration of four hundred dollars paid by Sarah Waldo of the same Worcester Lady the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said the said Sarah Waldo her heirs and assigns a certain tract of land and buildings situate on the West side of Green street in said Worcester bounded and described as follows (to wit) beginning on said Green street at the Southeast corner of land of Joseph D Gilbert thence Westerly and by said Gilbert's land to land of Willard Brown then Southerly by said Brown's land sixty feet to land of Frederick W Paine then Easterly on a line parallel with the first mentioned line and bounded Southerly on land of said Paine to said Green street then Northerly on said Green street sixty feet to the place of beginning being the same premises conveyed to me by deed of Frederick W Paine dated February 10th 1834 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for said County Book 297 Page 407 — To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Sarah Waldo her heirs and assigns to her & their use and behoof forever And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Sarah Waldo her heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises that they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Sarah Waldo and that I for myself my heirs executors and administrators will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Sarah Waldo her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all
