a certain note bearing date with these presents given by the
said Ezra Leland to the said Levi Rawson & Silas Rawson to
pay the same sum at the time aforesaid shall both be void
otherwise shall remain in full force, and it is agreed that
the mortgagor or his assigns shall remain in possession until
