 gage acknowledged on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April A.D. 1845 and recorded in  
 Worcester County Registry of deeds Book 396 page 495. And I the said  
 Ezra Seland do for myself my heirs executors and administrators  
 covenant with the said Willard Estlin Allen his heirs and assigns  
 that the grantors are lawfully seized in fee of the premises afore-  
 said that they are free of all incumbrances that the grantors have  
 good right to sell and convey the same to the said Willard Estlin  
 Allen and that I will warrant and defend the same premises  
 to the said Willard Estlin Allen his heirs and assigns forever  
 against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. And I  
 the said Hannah Seland wife of the said Ezra Seland do  
 hereby release and quit claim to the said Willard Estlin Allen  
 all my right and title of dower in and to the premises aforesaid.

 Levi Rawson, and Silas Rawson have hereunto set our hands and
