 full claims or demands of us or our heirs or of any person or persons claiming
 the same by through or under us or them forever to warrant & save and
 defend, In witness Whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seal the 4 day
 of July in the 32nd year of the Reign of George the Second King of Great Bri-

 within your precinct, you cause to be paid and satisfied unto D: Shilmon
 Atchington all needful in money the afores sums with four shillings more for costs
 and this writt and a former one and those also to satisfy you self for your own
 fees and for want of good Chittell or Land & mises to be by him shown
 unto you or found within your precinct to a Just cause of your Chittell more
 to
