And for the consideration aforesaid we, Mary J. C. Russell, Margaret A. Roberts, Emma F. Gile and Julia Holbrook, wives of the grantors do hereby release unto the said grantee and her heirs and assigns all rights of us to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
