forever. And I do hereby for myself and my
heirs, executors, and administrators covenant
with the said grantees and their heirs and
assigns that the granted premises are free
from all incumbrances made or suffered by
me and that I will, and my heirs, executors
and administrators shall, warrant and defend
the same to the said grantees and their
heirs and assigns forever against the lawful
claims and demands of all persons claiming
by, through, or under me, but against none
other.
