Taft his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land situated on Misca Hall socalled in Mendon viz. beginning at a point upon the Southerly side of the road leading from Charles A. Davenport's house in Mendon to Pearley P. Taft in Upton at a corner of land of Thomas Carey thence running Southerly and bounded easterly by land of said Carey as the wall now stands to a cross wall thence crossing said wall and continuing Southerly turning a little easterly and bounded easterly by land of said Carey to a corner of wall, thence turning and running Westerly and bounded Southerly by land of said Carey as the wall now stands to a corner of wall at land of John Keegan thence turning and running Northerly bounded Westerly by land of said Keegan as the wall now stands to the lane leaving
