W H E R E A S, the Connecticut River Transmission Company, of Boston, in the County of Suffolk, and Commonwealth aforesaid, has applied to the Board of Harbor and Land Commissioners for license to erect two towers on the upland at Jordan Pond in the Town of Shrewsbury and to string wires between said towers over and across said pond for transmission purposes, and has submitted plans of the same; and whereas due notice of said application, and of the time and place fixed for a hearing thereon, has been given, as required by law, to the Selectmen of the Town of Shrewsbury;

N O W, said Board, having heard all parties desiring to be heard, and having fully considered said application, hereby, subject to the approval of the Governor and Council, authorizes and licenses the said Connecticut River Transmission Company, subject to the provisions of the ninety-sixth chapter of the Revised Laws, and of all laws which are or may be in force applicable thereto, to erect two towers on the upland adjoining Jordan Pond in the Town of SHREWSBURY, on the land of Johannah Pond and property belonging to the Bigelow Estate, and to string wires between said towers over and across said pond for transmission purposes, in conformity with the accompanying plans No. 3694 and No. 3694 A, and in the location shown on said plans, said towers to be erected so that there will be not less than 60 feet between the same and the mean high water line of said pond. The clear height between the lowest wire strung between said towers to be not less than 30 feet above the mean high water level of the water in said pond, as shown on the accompanying plan No. 3694 A.
