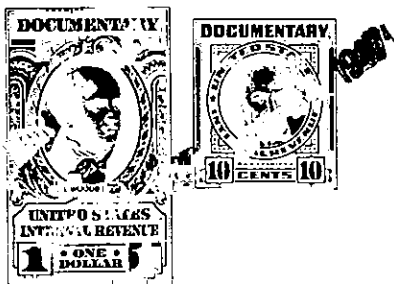
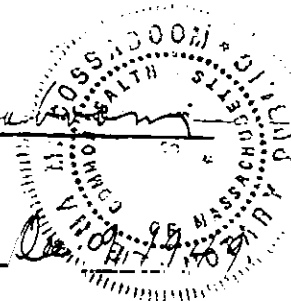

THAT WE, KISER HOLIDAY AND GLORIA T. HOLIDAY, husband and wife,

of Worcester, Worcester County, Massachusetts, being married, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor), for consideration paid, grant to the
