 in the County of Middlesex and State of the Massachusetts Bay in George Minot <sup>to</sup>  
 New England Yeoman for and in consideration of sixty six pounds  
 thirteen shillings & Four pence Lawfull Money paid me by George  
 Minot of Concord in the County and State aforesaid Gentleman y<sup>e</sup> receipt  
 whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give Grant sell & convey unto  
 the said George Minot his heirs & assigns forever the one half of a certain  
 piece or Tract of Land certainly by Estimation fifty acres buy some  
 more or less and lying in Princeton Near Wachusett Hill in the County of  
 Worcester and State aforesaid (the the aforesaid George Minot now owning  
 the Other half of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid fifty acres of Land in Equal halves with  
 me the aforesaid Nathan Meriam) it being parts of a tott of Land  
 which Samuel Minott John Jones Jun<sup>r</sup> and Nathan Meriam all of  
 Concord and Ebenezer Jones of Bedford formerly Bought of Silas  
 Whitney of Princeton aforesaid and Bounded as followeth viz beginning  
 at a Stake & heap of stones not far from the middle of the Westerly  
 Line of said Lott & running Eastwardly sixteen rods to a stake & stones  
 then turning a square Corner & running southerly Twenty rods to a stake  
 & stones then turning a square Corner & running Easterly by several  
 Stakes & <sup>heaps of</sup> stones till it comes to the Easterly line of y<sup>e</sup> Lott then turn-  
 ing a Corner & running southerly and bounded Eastwardly south-  
 wardly & westwardly till it comes to y<sup>e</sup> Bound first mentioned on  
 the line of the aforesaid Lott the particular Bounds of which will
