To all People to whom these presents shall come
Greeting knowe ye that I Aaron Legg of Mendon in the
County of Worcester Commonwealth of Massachusetts
Geman. In consideration of the sum of two hundred
& eighty Dollars paid to me by David Legg of Uxbridge
in the County and Commonwealth aforesaid Geman
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge ac-
tually given, granted and convey unto the said
David Legg his Heirs & Assigns a certain tract or par-
cel of lands & buildings lying & being in Mendon
aforesaid bounded as followeth (viz) beginning at a
rock near a small Elm Tree by the side of the
road leading through the premises thence North-
easterly to the South end of a large wall a little
west of the Barn then Northwesterly to a heap of stones
about one rod from the Northwest corner of the
Barn then Easterly & bounded Northwesterly by Nathan
Daniels's land to a heap of stones at Stephen John-
son's land being the most Northeasternmost corner
then Southerly & bounded Easterly by said John-
son's land to a heap of stones by the road leading
from Edward Rawfons to Darius Daniels; being the
most Southeasternmost corner then running South-
westerly by and with said road until it comes
to another corner of said Nathan Daniels' land
then turning Northwesterly by & with said Nathan's
land to a heap of stones near a spring of water
then westerly and bounded Southerly by said Nathan's
land to a heap of stones by the Old orchard so called be-
ing the most Southwesternmost corner then Northwesterly
& Northeastery by & with said Nathan Daniels's land
to a heap of stones by the road leading through
the premises being the most Northwestmost corner
then crossing said road & running with said road to
the first bounds. Together with my dwelling house
with all the privileges thereto belonging (not stand-
ing on the before mentioned premises) as it was
set off to Joel Legg as his wife portion out of the
