

Thence Easterly by said Knight's land about 23 rods to a stake  
 & thence Southerly by said Knight's land two rods to a stake & thence  
 thence Easterly by said Knight's & said Trasher's land about 39 rods to a  
 stake & thence Southerly by Suther Noys' land about 2 rods to  
 a stake & thence westerly by Perry Colby's land about 35 rods to  
 a stake & thence westerly by Elijah Norton's land about 30 rods to a town  
 Road from thence across said road to the first mentioned bound — Also  
 one other piece of land lying in said New Braintree containing about  
 seven acres bounded as follows viz — Westerly on a town road leading from  
 said New Braintree to Barre and north & east on land owned by said  
 Trasher as the fence now stands & South on the above described lot —

 lawful claims and demands of all persons —

Provided nevertheless that if the said George his heirs Executors or Ad-  
 ministrators pay to the said Joseph his heirs Executors Administrators or af-  
 fairs the sum of four hundred dollars in the following manner viz — one hun-  
 dred dollars in one year from the date of these presents one hundred dollars  
 in two years one hundred dollars in three years & one hundred dollars  
 in four years from this date with the interest annually thereon the said  
 also four certain notes bearing even date with these presents given by the  
 said George to the said Joseph to pay the same sums at the times aforesaid  
 shall likewise be void otherwise shall remain in full force — The wit-  
 nesses whereof we the said George Mullet & Roxana wife of the said  
 George in token of relinquishment of my right of dower in the premises  
 have hereunto set our hand & seals this first day of April in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen —
