of Worcester and Commonwealth aforesaid bounded and described
as follows viz. bounded on land of Charles Mirick Esq. and land of
Luther Paninter and on the town road and is the same which
is occupied by Elishus Copeland and is part of the farm formerly
owned by Ezekiel Rice of said Princetown deceased and is the
same which was set of to Elizabeth Rice Widow of the said Ezekiel
Rice as her dower or thirds. — To have and to hold the

aforesaid premises with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereto belonging to him the said Joseph Cutting Jr. his heirs
and assigns forever so that neither I the said Lucy Rice nor my heirs
or any other person or persons claiming from under me or them
or in the name right or stead of me or them shall or will by any
way or means have claim or demand any right or title to the
